# WHAT ARE THE RULES?

With a few exceptions, rod fishing from the edge of the quay in Copenhagen Harbour is permitted.


- You may only fish with a rod, not with a net, traps etc.
- During the summer season from May to 30 September, when there is often dense traffic on the water and at the quay, you may not fish in the Inner Harbour – in other words, from Bryggebroen in the south to Langelinie in the north
- Fishing is not permitted in special commercial (ISPS) areas, regardless of the time of year
- You may not fish from a belly boat etc.
- Bottom and coarse fishing are not permitted in the harbour
- Always pull in your line for harbour traffic and watch out for other people when casting

Although the water area in the harbour may be used for recreational fishing, please bear in mind that there may be local regulations and private wharfs and jetties along the harbour, which require a special fishing permit. Most sailing clubs and jetty owners do not allow fishing from their facilities.

#### REMEMBER A VALID FISHING LICENCE

Fishing in the harbour requires a valid fishing licence. You can purchase then online from the Danish Fisheries Agency at fisketegn.dk

# TIPS FOR YOUR FISHING TRIP

In Copenhagen Harbour, rod fishing is permitted just about everywhere. The harbour abounds with fish such as sea trout, cod, hornfish and bull-rout. Although the water in the harbour is so clean that you can swim in it, there are sediments with concentrations of mercury at the bottom. Therefore, you should not eat groundfish caught in the harbour, because they contain too much mercury.

- Fish when fishing. There is so much traffic in the harbour. Always pay attention to your line and do not do other things while fishing
- Do not eat groundfish. They may contain excessive amounts of mercury
- Tidy up. It is good harbour etiquette to tidy up after yourself when you have finished fishing.
